

Performing Manufacturing Operations **Level 2**

- +** Levy introduced in April 2017
- +** Companies with wage bills over £3 million pay a levy of 0.5% of their salary bill through PAYE
- +** Smaller companies not paying the levy can access a SME fund with a 10% contribution
- +** Companies can draw down on the levy to fund apprenticeship training programmes
- +** EFIA partnered with SkillCert to offer PMO (Performing Manufacturing Operations) apprenticeship, Level 2, which is a nationally recognised qualification and incorporates the EFIA training modules.



Foundation Apprenticeship in Performing Manufacturing Operations (Level 2)

The Performing Manufacturing Operations (PMO) level 2 is a nationally recognised qualification and is designed to provide evidence of an employee's ability to perform particular roles in manufacturing industries.

The programme can be applied to various operational performances related to processing, production, assembly and reworking of materials and products within the manufacturing, logistics and supply chain sectors.

This qualification will benefit employers by demonstrating the quality of a workforce to existing and potential customers as well as maintaining employee morale and motivation. Employees will benefit from acquiring the evidence base for potential progression and career development in the industry.

On completion of this Apprenticeship you will achieve the following Qualifications:

- EAL Level 2 NVQ Diploma in Performing Manufacturing Operations (QCF)
- EAL Level 2 Award in Industrial Environmental Awareness (QCF)
- Functional Skills – Maths and English (England Only)

Course Delivery

The recommended time for completion of the apprenticeship framework is 13 months. Delivery includes a combination of classroom based delivery, on the job assessment and project driven activities. All delivery takes place at the candidates place of work.


